Thank you for your interest in preserving the heritage and character of La Jolla! The annual Jewel Awards of the Historical Society, organized by the La Jolla Landmark Group, recognize the patience, perseverance, resources and talent that go into such preservation efforts.

Projects for Jewel Awards for Restoration or Rehabilitation may be nominated by owners, architects, contractors or others. Nominees are evaluated on the basis of available information, photographic evidence, and interviews with key stakeholders. Properties do not need to be historically designated buildings, but the Secretary of Interior's Standards for Preservation/Historic Rehabilitation are used in the review of nominations. Award winners are then selected by the Historical Society's Board of Directors, and announced at a private celebration.
